Primary Link is a partnership with Swedish Emergency Services to help you get connected with a primary care provider for your medical care.

Why is having a primary care provider important?

Primary care providers are the quarterbacks of patient care. They help ensure that you get the right care, in the right setting, by the most appropriate practitioners.

Primary care providers build long-term relationships with patients and get to know you as a whole person — both your health issues and your personal values. They also provide ongoing care for chronic problems like heart disease or diabetes. A primary care provider can treat your ills or ailments, and they can also notice health issues before they become serious health challenges.

At Primary Link, we want to help you find the right primary care provider for you at a convenient location. We'll help schedule and confirm the initial appointments you need and even call you with reminders.
